# RECENT FILM PROJECTS IN THE HEALTH SECTOR

## Relationships & Me

The PCT commissioned The Mill Group to create a thought provoking film, which would allow young disabled people to express their emotions, thoughts and feelings about relationships as they progress through their teenage years.

This film had 2 overriding objectives; firstly through it's making it would allow this group to create a dialogue of trust between themselves to discuss their experiences and feelings, secondly the finished film could be shown to other audiences to facilitate discussion and dismiss inaccurate perceptions that disabilities have an impact on this groups desire for a fulfilling relationship.

The film will be used as a national awareness film regarding these issues.

## Substance Misuse Awareness films

Calderdale Primary Care Trust commissioned the Mill Group to deliver an accredited video production course to The Recovery Group in Calderdale. The Recovery Group deals with people aiming to recover from substance abuse.

Working with the group and Calderdale Primary Care Trust we produced a series of short video diary films, documenting the experiences of The Recovery Group members whilst using and recovering from substance misuse. The video diaries were honest and frank opinions about the local health service and their experiences with particular emphasis on possible improvements. The film was used as an awareness and training piece in conjunction with a training day for local health professionals. The films were then used on a larger project working with a local secondary school to produce a regional schools film, which communicated the health and social issues surrounding substance misuse for young people.

## Health Signposting Project for Asylum Seekers and E.U. Migrants

**The Mill Group delivered a 6 week multimedia and photography course working with a Halifax based community centre which helps asylum seekers, refugees and E.U. Migrants.**

The NHS project was to produce a series of posters and a website which directed people from these typically hard to reach groups towards local health services in their area. The aim was to work with a group of asylum seekers and Eastern European migrants to develop an interactive map and collage posters of health care facilities in the West Central part of Halifax. To include the 6 main medical centres, opticians, doctors, dentists, hospitals etc. The interactive map included photographs taken by the group of all the local health provision buildings and key public facing individuals within those organisations. The project has helped communicate with people who's first language is not English about how and where to access local health services on a very simple easy to understand level.

## NHS Induction films

**The Mill Group have produced a series of short NHS induction films to aid with the recruitment and induction process of new health professionals. The films have contained interviews with patients, senior managers and directors, informative graphics and a collation of photographs and previously captured video footage.**

The films have been made interactive with the audience where appropriate and have triggered discussion or break out groups to enhance the induction day. The films have helped to embed information, familiarisation with the organisation and have helped with people resources where senior managers previously had to attend all induction sessions.
